ORDER REOPENING

By Decision No. 82147 dated November 20, 1973, S.M.D.S., Inc., doing business as Santa Monica Delivery Service, was granted interim authority to depart from the minimum rates set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff 15 by charging base yearly vehicle unit rates not less than 8.8 percent less than the otherwise applicable rates when transporting tires, batteries, and accessories for General Tire & Rubber Company in Los Angeles and Orange Counties. By Decision No. 82877 dated May 15, 1974, the authority was extended for a period of one year. By letter dated May 20, 1974, the California Trucking Association requests that the matter be set for public hearing.
