OPINION

Southern Pacific Transportation Company requests authority to construct two industrial drill tracks at grade across Junction Avenue in the City of San Jose.

FINDINGS

After consideration, the Commission finds:

- 1. Applicant should be authorized to construct two industrial drill tracks at grade across Junction Avenue in San Jose, County of Santa Clara, at the locations and substantially as shown by plans attached to the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. DA-47.07-C and DA-46.39-C.
- 2. The Commission finds with reasonable certainty that this project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
