ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By the above-entitled complaint the complainant, Lorrie Nassofer, seeks to recover from M. C. Jones, dba Maynard Van and Storage, the sum of \$154.25 for an allegedly fraudulent estimate of and the collection of excessive moving and storage charges.

On May 28, 1974 the defendant filed an answer wherein he alleges, among other defenses, that complainant recovered a judgment on this moving and storage claim in the Small Claims Court of the city of Los Angeles for the sum of \$200 plus costs of \$9.20, and that this sum has been paid.

The Commission has secured a certified copy of the judgment in the action referred to by defendant (Exhibit 1 herein).

The defendant, having satisfied the claim of complainant by payment pursuant to execution in the Small Claims Court of the Los Angeles Judicial District,

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IT IS ORDERED that the complaint is dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
