SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 83120 dated July 9, 1974 in Application No. 54141, the Commission ordered:

"6. The authority granted by this order to issue stock will become effective when the issuer has paid the fee prescribed by Section 1904.1 of the Public Utilities Code, which fee is \$20. In other respects the effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof."

The fee stated is erroneous in amount and should be \$50, the minimum fee required.

IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 6 of Decision No. 83120 dated July 9, 1974 is amended to read:

"6. The authority granted by this order to issue stock will become effective when the issuer has paid the fee prescribed by Section 1904.1 of the Public Utilities Code, which fee is \$50. In other respects the effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof."
