ORDER EXTENDING PERIOD OF SUSPENSION

By an order of suspension and investigation, issued April 2, 1974, certain tariff sheets filed under Advice Letter No. 50 by Industrial Communications Systems, Inc. were suspended until August 2, 1974, pending public hearing and further order of the Commission. It appears that conclusion of the matter may not be accomplished by August 2, 1974.

Good Cause appearing therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the operation and effectiveness of the tariff sheets filed by respondent's Advice Letter No. 50 are hereby suspended, as provided by statute, for an additional period of six months to and including February 2, 1975, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served forthwith on Industrial Communication Systems, Inc., and to send a copy to Intrastate Radiotelephone, Inc. of San Bernardino, and Radio Dispatch Corporation of Upland.
