ORDER CANCELLING PRESCRIPTIVE RIGHTS  
AND DISMISSING APPLICATION IN PART

By this application 20th Century Trucking Company requests authorization of this Commission to merge 20th Century Delivery Service, a wholly owned subsidiary of applicant, into applicant which will be the surviving company. By letter dated March 22, 1974 applicant requested that the prescriptive rights to operate as an express company held by 20th Century Delivery Service be canceled. Other than those rights 20th Century Delivery Service holds no other rights from this Commission. Applicant represents that there has been no operation under the subject express right for the past 20 years. ✓

The Commission finds and concludes that the subject express rights should be canceled and that the application should be otherwise dismissed for want of jurisdiction of this Commission.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive express rights held by 20th Century Delivery Service are canceled and its Local Freight Tariff, Cal. P.U.C. (C.R.C.) 6 is canceled.

2. The application is otherwise dismissed.
