ORDER EXTENDING STAY OF DECISION NO. 82933

Petitions for rehearing of Decision No. 82933 have been filed by the State Department of Transportation, the County of Santa Clara, and the Southern Pacific Transportation Company. By virtue of the provisions of Section 1733 of the Public Utilities Code, Decision No. 82933 was thereby stayed. The Commission, on its own motion, is of the opinion that said decision and order should be stayed for such period as is required for the careful evaluation of the petitions for rehearing. This extension of stay will be issued for the sole purpose of affording the Commission sufficient time to fully evaluate the contentions of said petitions for rehearing.

IT IS ORDERED that the stay of Decision No. 82933 is hereby extended until further order of the Commission.
