SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Exception Ratings Tariff 1 (ERT 1) contains various exception ratings which apply in lieu of those named in National Motor Freight Classification NMF 100 A and govern various minimum rate tariffs making specific reference thereto. Certain of these exception ratings refer to specific item numbers in said classification for descriptions of the commodities involved.

It has been brought to the Commission's attention that the item number in the aforementioned classification for one of these commodity descriptions was changed without a corresponding change being made in ERT 1 to the item number reference therein to such commodity description.²

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the necessary correction should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Exception Ratings Tariff 1 should be amended accordingly.

Minimum Rate Tariffs 1-B, 2, 9-B and 19.

The commodity description for certain adhesives in Sub 3 of Item 4620 of National Motor Freight Classification NMF 100 was reissued in Sub 5 of Item 4620 of Supplement 20 to said classification pursuant to Decision No. 81915 dated September 25, 1973 in Application No. 54253.

Exception Ratings Tariff 1 (Appendix A to Decision No. 66195, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective September 6, 1974, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix by this reference are made a part hereof. 2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject to Decision No. 66195, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustment in the commodity

- description ordered herein.
- 3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of this order shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and shall be made effective not later than September 6, 1974.
- 4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendment authorized hercinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendment published under this authority shall make reference to the prior

C. 7858 (Pet. 158) - LTC orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order. 5. In all other respects, Decision No. 66195, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof. Dated at San Francisco, California, this 6Th day of August, 1974. Commissioners Commissioner D. W. Holmes, being necessarily absent, did not participate in the disposition of this proceeding.
