SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 78264, as amended by Decision No. 78472, in this proceeding established charges in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 for transportation within the Los Angeles Metropolitan Area of shipments weighing less than 1,000 pounds.

It has been brought to the Commission's attention that the application of the aforementioned shipment charges is not clear with respect to the transportation of commodities which are rated over Class 100.¹

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the tariff provisions in question should be clarified by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Minimum Rate Tariff 2 should be amended accordingly.

¹The application of such charges is set forth in Note 1 of Item 530 of Minimum Rate Tariff 2.

Minor changes not involved in this proceeding will be made by the order herein.²

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective September 6, 1974, Sixty-second Revised Page 5, Fourteenth Revised Page 5-A, Fifty-seventh Revised Page 7, and Thirteenth Revised Page 44-C, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications required or authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of this order shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public; such tariff publications as are required shall be made effective not later than September 6, 1974; and as to tariff publications which are authorized but not required, the authority shall expire unless exercised within sixty days after the effective date of this order.


3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendment authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendment published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.


²The Index of Commodities in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 will be amended to include various commodities not currently listed therein.


4. In all other respects Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

NOTE 3--For shipments having point of origin or point of destination on a wharf, the shipment charge shall be that charge determined under other provisions of this item, plus 110 cents per shipment.				
NOTE 4--(Exception to paragraphs 2, 3 and 5 of Item 90 - Mixed Shipments). When provisions of this item are applied to a shipment consisting of articles subject to different ratings, the following shall apply:				
(a) When 10 percent or less of the weight of the shipment consists of articles rated above Class 100, the shipment charge shall be computed at 125 percent of the charge in Column A or Column B.				
(b) When more than 10 percent, but less than 30 percent of the weight of the shipment consists of articles rated above Class 100, and none of the articles is rated above Class 200, the shipment charge shall be computed at 150 percent of the charge in Column A or Column B.
