Application of SYSTEM 99, a California corporation, and TRANS WESTERN EXPRESS, INC. (formerly Bend-Portland Truck Service, Inc.), an Oregon corporation, to transfer the certificate of public convenience and necessity of TRANS WESTERN EXPRESS, INC. to SYSTEM 99.

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 82952 System 99 was authorized to acquire the operating authority of Trans Western Express, Inc., subject to the approval of the Interstate Commerce Commission.

System 99 requests a supplemental order authorizing its published rates to prevail over the tariffs of Trans Western where conflicts may exist.

It is alleged that the inconsistencies relate primarily to rules and regulations in the tariff and not generally to its substance of charges or rates.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that to the extent that conflicts may exist between the published tariffs of System 99 and Trans Western Express, Inc. the tariff provisions of System 99 shall prevail and

the rates and rules of Trans Western Express, Inc. applying thereto shall be canceled. System 99 shall amend Trans Western Express, Inc. tariffs on file with the Commission, on not less than one day's notice, to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
