## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Interim Decision No. 83124, issued July 9, 1974 in the captioned proceedings, among other things, found that the minimum weight applicable to weighed shipments of asphaltic concrete, cold road oil mixture, sand, gravel, and certain other aggregates should be reduced from 24 tons to 23 tons. It has come to the attention of the Commission that through inadvertence the intent of that finding was not included in Items 270, 280, 290, 300, 310, 320, 530, 540, 550, and 560 of Minimum Rate Tariff 7-A (MRT 7-A). Also, the three percent fuel surcharge authorized by Decision No. 82453 was inadvertently cancelled with respect to Antelope Valley Zone rates in Items 490 and 510 of MRT 7-A. The surcharge should be restored. The provisions of MRT 7-A will be amended accordingly.

It has also come to the Commission's attention that Decision No. 83124 may not clearly express the Commission's intention with respect to the scope of the further hearings to be scheduled in the captioned proceedings. It is the Commission's intention to receive additional evidence from any party with respect to all issues raised in the rehearing of Decision No. 82061 ordered by Decision No. 82592 in Petition 213, and as to all issues raised in Petition 265.

C. 5437, Pet. 265, OSH 213 ep IT IS ORDERED that: 1. Minimum Rate Tariff 7-A (Appendix B to Decision No. 82061, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective September 3, 1974, the revised pages contained in Appendix A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof. 2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of this order shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized by this order, are authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order. -2C. 5437, Pet. 265, OSH 213 ep

4. In all other respects, Decision No. 82061, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be ten days after the date hereof.


