ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Subsequent to the filing of the above-entitled complaint, the Commission entered its Fourth Interim Opinion and Order in Case No. 9581, an Investigation on the Commission's Own Motion Into the Adequacy and Reliability of the Energy and Fuel Requirements of the Electric Public Utilities in the State of California. (Decision No. 82881 dated May 15, 1974.)

On May 28, 1974 the assigned examiner notified the parties herein that the matter appeared to be moot in the light of Decision No. 82881. The parties were given until June 14, 1974 to notify the Commission if they believed that any justiciable issue remained to be determined by the Commission.
