O P I N I O N

Transignal Corporation, a California corporation,
seeks authority to control Signal Trucking Service, Ltd.

Signal Trucking Service, Ltd. operates under certificated
and permitted authority granted by this Commission and under
Interstate Commerce Commission authority.

Transignal Corporation, which has not heretofore
conducted any business operations, proposes to acquire all of the
outstanding shares of capital stock of Signal Trucking Service, Ltd.,
and to issue 6,907 shares of its capital stock to the present
shareholders of Signal Trucking Service, Ltd. in proportions
identical to those now prevailing with reference to Signal
Trucking Service, Ltd. stock.


After consideration the Commission finds that control
of Signal Trucking Service, Ltd. by Transignal Corporation would
not be adverse to the public interest, and concludes that the
application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.
The action taken herein shall not be construed as a finding of
value of the stock of Signal Trucking Service, Ltd.


O R D E R


IT IS ORDERED that Transignal Corporation may control Signal Trucking Service, Ltd.


The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof, or the date on which Signal Trucking Service, Ltd. submits to this Commission the proposed in-lieu certificates of public convenience and necessity required by Ordering Paragraph No. 6 of Decision No. 82262, dated December 18, 1973, whichever date is later.
