ORDER EXTENDING STAY
OF DECISION NO. 82946

On June 5, 1974 the Commission issued Decision No. 82946. The effective date of said decision was to be June 25, 1974. A petition for rehearing of Decision No. 82946 was filed by Greyhound Lines, Inc. (Western Division) on June 14, 1974. Since the petition for rehearing was filed more than ten days before the effective date of Decision No. 82946, said decision was stayed.

The Commission, on its own motion, is of the opinion that the stay of Decision No. 82946 should be extended until further order of the Commission. The extension of the stay is made for the sole purpose of affording the Commission sufficient time to fully evaluate the contentions of the petition for rehearing.
