ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On July 30, 1974 the Commission entered Decision No. 83225, its Fifth Interim Order in Case No. 9581, an Investigation on the Commission's Own Motion into the Adequacy and Reliability of the Energy and Fuel Requirements of the Electric Public Utilities in the State of California. Decision No. 83225 temporarily suspended the prohibitions and curtailment provisions of Paragraph (a) of Appendix A to Decision No. 82881.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds and concludes that the above-entitled complaint has become moot. The provisions of defendant's Rule 14.1 complained of herein are not presently in effect and there is no present controversy between the parties with respect thereto.

IT IS ORDERED that complaint in Case No. 9700 is hereby dismissed.
