ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This application was filed on December 6, 1973. Counsel for applicant withdrew on January 9, 1974. A letter dated January 14, 1974 was mailed to applicant's last address. No reply was ever received, although another attorney advised he was representing applicant by a letter dated January 22, 1974 and requested that a 120-day continuance be authorized. Counsel was advised by letter on February 27, 1974 that a hearing date should be selected. No reply was received and another application (No. 54319) filed by Bonanza Airways on September 11, 1973 was dismissed for lack of prosecution by Decision No. 82983 dated June 18, 1974. There has been no communication from applicant since Application No. 54319 was dismissed and no request to schedule Application No. 54485 for hearing.
