SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 81668 Signal Trucking Service, Ltd. was granted authority to depart from the provisions of the Commission's minimum rate orders and General Order No. 84-Series in connection with property transported by the Proctor & Gamble Distributing Company. The authority was scheduled to expire August 20, 1974.

By letter dated July 29, 1974, applicant has requested that the authority be extended to October 21, 1974. The reason for the requested extension is that the carrier and the shipper are discussing the level of rates to be applied in the future, and the additional time is needed in order to complete the necessary analysis and discussion.

A copy of the letter was mailed to the California Trucking Association. No objection to the granting of the extension has been received.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The expiration date of Decision No. 81668 is hereby extended to October 21, 1974.
