A. 54938 FBC** 3. It is reasonably certain that the project involved in this proceeding will not have a significant effect on the environment. CONCLUSIONS On the basis of the foregoing findings, we conclude that the application should be granted as set forth in the following order: ORDER IT IS ORDERED that: 1. The Forest Service, Department of Agriculture, is authorized to construct a Forest Transportation System Road named North Canyon No. 26N31 at grade over the tracks of The Western Pacific Railroad Company near Greenville in Plumas County at the location and substantially as shown by plans attached to the application to be identified as Crossing No. 4K-15.6. 2. Construction of the crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 (General Order No. 72-B). 3. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet with grades of approach as shown on the plan attached to the application. 4. Clearances shall conform to General Order No. 26-D. Walkways shall conform to General Order No. 118. 5. Protection at the crossing shall be two Standard No. 9 automatic gates (General Order No. 75-C). 6. Installation and maintenance costs of the automatic protection shall be borne by the applicant. 7. Maintenance of the crossing shall be in accordance with General Order No. 72-B. 8. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. - 2 -
