## ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Lowell E. Mast, Mary Grace Mast Richey, Jack D. Mast and Calvin Cowles Mast, doing business as Mast Iron Warehouse, possess a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Esparto and vicinity in Yolo County.

Lowell E. Mast has informed the Commission by letter that the partnership has not engaged in the public utility warehouse business for approximately two years and does not intend to do so in the future. He requests that the operative right be revoked.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that revocation of the prescriptive operative right, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the operative right should be revoked and the tariff applicable to the services thereunder should be canceled.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Lowell E. Mast, Mary Grace Mast Richey, Jack D. Mast and Calvin Cowles Mast, doing business as Mast Iron Warehouse, as determined by the Commission's order dated August 1, 1960 in Case No. 6723, is hereby revoked.

2. Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of Lowell E. Mast, Mary Grace Mast Richey, Jack D. Mast and Calvin Cowles Mast, doing business as Mast Iron Warehouse, from the involved tariff or tariffs of California Warehouse Tariff Bureau on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made within 90 days after the effective date of this order and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Lowell E. Mast, Mary Grace Mast Richey, Jack D. Mast and Calvin Cowles Mast or to mail a certified copy thereof to them at their last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
