ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

San Francisco Warehouse Co., a corporation, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at San Jose.

San Francisco Warehouse Co., requested authority to suspend its public utility warehouse operations at San Jose for the reason that it had lost its lease and was unable to find suitable space at San Jose in which to resume operations. It was authorized to suspend such operations until March 1, 1973, pursuant to Decision No. 79766 dated February 25, 1972, in Application No. 53102.

Mr. Lloyd Swayne, Jr., President of the corporation, has informed the Commission by letter that the utility is unable to find a suitable facility to continue this operation. He requests that the operative right be revoked.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that revocation of the warehouse operative right, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the operative right should be revoked and the tariff or tariffs applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman acquired by San Francisco Warehouse Co., a corporation, by Decision No. 60025 dated May 3, 1960, in Application No. 42037 for the operation of warehouse storage or floor space at San Jose is hereby revoked.

2. Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of San Francisco Warehouse Co. from the involved tariff or tariffs of California Warehouse Tariff Bureau on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made within 90 days after the effective date of this order and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon San Francisco Warehouse Co. or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
