ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

- C. A. Buck Moving and Storage Company, a corporation, possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at San Mateo.
- C. W. Carlon, President of the corporation, has informed the Commission by letter that the utility has phased out its public warehousing at its facility in San Mateo and has not engaged in any public warehousing for the last two years. He requests that the warehouse operative right be revoked.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that revocation of the certificate, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the prescriptive operative right should be revoked and the tariff applicable to the services thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to C. A. Buck Moving and Storage Company, a corporation, by Decision No. 75417 dated March 11, 1969, in Case No. 6946, is hereby revoked.
- 2. C. A. Buck Moving and Storage Co. Warehouse Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1 (C. A. Buck Series), is hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon C. A. Buck Moving and Storage Company or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

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This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
