# SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 31142 of March 13, 1973, in these proceedings established an exception rating in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 of Class 35.3, minimum weight 45,000 pounds. applicable to Food Curing, Preserving or Seasoning Compounds.1

It has been brought to the Commission's attention that the provisions pertaining to free time allowance for loading of the aforementioned commodities are not clear.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the tariff provisions in question should be clarified by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Minimum Rate Tariff 2 should be amended accordingly.

<sup>1</sup> The application of such rating is set forth in Item 347 of Minimum Rate Tariff 2. One hour free time for loading is provided in Note 8 of said item but the provisions therein pertaining to the computation of time erroneously refer to place of unloading and completion of unloading.

C. 7858 (Pet. 144) and C. 5432 - ANVMinor changes not involved in this proceeding will also be made by the order herein.<sup>2</sup> IT IS ORDERED that: 1. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective September 27, 1974, Forty-seventh Revised Page 8, Fifty-second Revised Page 9, Eleventh Revised Page 9-A, and First Revised Page 37-BBB, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject to Decision No. 31606, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the amendment necessary to conform with the further adjustment ordered herein. 3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of this order shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and shall be made effective not later than September 27. 1974. 4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendment authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendment published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing longand short-haul departures and to this order. <sup>2</sup>The Index of Commodities in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 will be amended to include various commodities not currently listed therein. -2-

5. In all other respects Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

NOTE 1Applies only when all provisions of the following notes are met. Otherwise, provisions of the Governing Classification or of this tariff shall apply.		
NOTE 2Rates resulting from application of the provisions of this item may not be used in combination with any other rates.		
NOTE 3Applies only in connection with prepaid shipments released to one-half of actual value or 50 cents per pound per article, whichever is less. Shipper must enter the following statement on the bill of lading or shipping document:		
"The agreed or declared value of the property is hereby stated by the shipper to be one-half of actual value or 50 cents per pound, per article, whichever is less."		
If shipper fails or declines to declare such value in writing, the provisions of this item will not apply.		
NOTE 4Applies only in connection with shipments loaded by consigner and unloaded by consignee with power equipment, furnished and used without expense to the carrier. In such circumstances, physical assistance of the carrier employee is restricted to work within or on carrier's equipment and does not include sorting, stacking, unstacking, removal or placement of merchandise on pallets.		ø3
NOTE 5.~-Not more than ten component parts shall be permitted in connection with shipments moving in split pickup or split delivery service.	·	
NOTE 6If more than one vehicle or combination of vehicles constituting a single unit of carrier's equipment is used for the transportation of a single shipment moving under rates in this item, each such vehicle or combination of vehicles shall be subject to the minimum weight named herein.		
NOTE 7 The provisions of this item will not apply to shipments for which temperature control service is provided.		
gNOTE 8An allowance of one hour free time for loading shall be allowed for each unit of equipment used. Time shall be computed from the time of arrival of carrier's equipment at place of loading ** until loading ** is completed and equipment is released. Excess loading ** time shall be charged for at the rates named in Item 145 herein.		
NOTE 9The free weight of pallets containing commodities moving under provisions of this item is limited to 5% of the weight on which transportation charges are computed.		
NOTE 10 When moving in mixed shipments with other commodities not named in this item, the entire shipment shall be subject to the provisions of Notes 4 through 9 hereof.		
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
