O P I N I O N

Applicant requests authority to abandon the nonagency station at Fremont, County of Yolo, State of California.

It is alleged that the only railroad facility at Fremont is a double-ended side track approximately 950 feet in length and that said siding is not used for operating purposes. There have been no shipments received or forwarded at Fremont station in the last 14 years.

There were no protests.

Upon consideration of all the facts, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity do not require the continuance of the nonagency station at Fremont, County of Yolo. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Sacramento Northern Railway is authorized to abandon its nonagency station at Fremont, County of Yolo.

2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Sacramento Northern Railway shall file in duplicate, amendments to its tariffs showing the deletion authorized herein and shall make reference in such tariffs to this decision as authority for this change.

3. Within thirty days after the change herein authorized, applicant shall notify this Commission in writing thereof.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
