ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Robert C. Crabb, dba Mt. Shasta Radiotelephone Company, having requested in writing on August 19, 1974, an extension of time in which to comply with that portion of its certificate granted by Decision No. 77573 which relates to the construction and operation of a public utility radiotelephone system for service to the Cities of Mt. Shasta, Weed, McCloud and Dunsmuir and for which the Federal Communications Commission has not yet issued a Construction Permit due to their heavy backlog of applications, and it appearing to the Commission that a one-year extension should be granted; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the time for compliance with ordering paragraph No. 5 of Decision No. 77573 is extended to and including August 24, 1975.

In all other respects, Decision No. 77573 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
