ORDER REVOKING CEMENT CARRIER OPERATIVE RIGHT

By Resolution No. TS-149, dated December 18, 1973, the cement carrier authority granted to Juan Martinez and John Martinez, a partnership, doing business as Martinez Trucking, by Resolution No. 13920, dated August 11, 1964, in this proceeding was suspended effective December 31, 1973. The authority was suspended because the carrier failed to maintain on file with the Commission its rates, rules, charges and classifications as required by Section 486 of the Public Utilities Code.

The carrier's participation in various tariffs published by Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., was canceled effective November 30, 1973. No new filings have been made.

Therefore, good cause appearing, the Commission finds that the cement carrier certificate should be revoked. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:



The cement carrier certificate granted to Juan Martinez and John Martinez, doing business as Martinez Trucking, by Resolution No. 13920 dated August 11, 1964, in Application No. 46475, is hereby revoked upon the effective date of this order unless on or before such date the required tariffs are filed or a request for public hearing is received.


