By Decision No. 83087, issued July 2, 1974, the Commission denied the specific relief requested by the amended complaint filed herein, but ordered Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company (PT&T) to apply to the Commission by December 31, 1975, for authorization to offer subscribers in the Pacific Beach and La Jolla exchange areas optional extended area service between all exchanges of the San Diego Metropolitan Extended Area.




