ORDER REFLECTING NAME CHANGE OF SHIPPER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 82047 dated October 30, 1973 is amended to read as follows:

1. Jerry T. and Millard F. Kern, doing business as Kern Bros., are authorized to deviate from the applicable minimum rates and rules set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 for the transportation of carbon coke for Republic Carbon Products, Inc. (formerly known as Amax Carbon Products, Inc.), between Bakersfield and points within 500 miles of Bakersfield but only to the extent and at no less than the rates set out in Appendix A.

2. Numbered paragraph 2 of Appendix A to Decision No. 82047 dated October 30, 1974 is amended to read as follows:

2. Territory - Between the plant of Republic Carbon Products, Inc. (formerly known as Amax Carbon Products, Inc.) at or near Bakersfield, California, to points and places in California within 500 miles of said plant. Said mileage to be computed in accordance with the provisions of the Commission Distance Table No. 7, or successive issues thereof.
