ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT
AND MODIFYING PRIOR ORDER

On September 3, 1974, San Diego Gas and Electric Company (SDG&E) filed an application for modification of Decision No. 80811 with an attached stipulation of the parties. SDG&E states that pursuant to agreement of all of the parties in both complaint proceedings, it has undertaken certain work and construction to relocate a utility pole to a position which satisfies all of the complainants herein.^{1/} SDG&E states that said construction achieves a result which was sought to be attained by compliance with Decision No. 80811.

^{1/} Each complainant had sought a Commission order which would require SDG&E to relocate the pole to a position unacceptable to the other.

In view of the allegations of SDG&E, and in view of the fact that the parties, both SDG&E and all complainants, are in agreement on the location of the pole, the proposed stipulation should be accepted and Decision No. 80811 modified accordingly.

IT IS ORDERED that the stipulation of the parties is hereby accepted in settlement of the instant proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the ordering paragraph in Decision No. 80811 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"IT IS ORDERED that defendant shall immediately remove the new pole, install suitable facilities of the type and at the location agreeable to all parties involved in this matter, and do such work as is necessary to continue service to its existing customers."

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
