ORDER VACATING THE STAY OF THE EFFECTIVE DATES OF DECISIONS
NOS. 81518, 82035 AND 82157, AND MODIFYING, AS NECESSARY, DECISION NO. 82157

In Decision No. 81518 we ordered that Minimum Rate Tariff 4-B (MRT 4-B) shall be amended. The specific tariff revisions were to be accomplished by separate order but were to become effective sixty days after the effective date of Decision No. 81518. However, pursuant to the timely filing of a petition for rehearing by California Moving & Storage Association, Inc., et al (CMSA), the orders of Decision No. 81518 were suspended (Public Util. Code, Section 1733).

On October 24, 1973 we denied the petition for rehearing by Decision No. 82035. This decision provided that "... [t]he effective date of Decision No. 81518 is the date of this order."

On November 20, 1974 we issued Decision No. 82157. Decision

No. 82157 constituted the "separate order" contemplated by Decision

No. 81518 and amended MRT 4-B by incorporating therein the specific tariff revisions ordered in said Decision No. 81518. These revisions were to become effective December 23, 1973.

IS C.5330, OSH 68

On November 21 and 23, 1973, CMSA and Bekins Moving & Storage Co. (Bekins), respectively, filed petitions for Writ of Review with the Supreme Court of California seeking review of Decision No. 81518. On November 21, 1973, a Petition to Intervene and Request to File Points and Authorities in support of CMSA was filed by Bevan-Pearson Moving Storage, Inc., et al (Bevan-Pearson). On December 7, 1973 the Commission issued Decision No. 82244, staying the effective dates of Decisions Nos. 81518, 82035 and 82157 pending the Court's determination of the subject petitions.

On July 17, 1974 the Court denied the Petitions for Writ of Review and the Petition to Intervene. On August 1, 1974 CMSA filed a petition with the Court seeking rehearing of the Court's July 17, 1974 order. After extending the time in which to consider this petition, the Court denied rehearing on August 28, 1974.

On September 10, 1974 CMSA filed with the Commission a petition titled "Petition of California Moving & Storage Association, et al. for a Continuance of the Commission's Order in Decision No. 82244, dated December 7, 1973, Staying the Effective Date of Decisions Nos. 81518, 82035 and 82157 Pending Determination of Petitioners' Petition for Writ of Certiorari by the Supreme Court of the United States."

Having considered each and every allegation of the petition filed by CMSA on September 10, 1974, we are of the opinion that good cause for continuing the stay previously granted by Decision No. 82244 has not been shown. CMSA's petition must therefore be denied.

We therefore conclude that the stay of Decisions Nos. 81518, 82035 and 82157 should now be vacated, and the specific tariff revisions established thereby should now be effectuated. However, it should be noted that since the issuance of Decision No. 82157, the specific tariff pages revised by that decision have been further modified in certain respects not related to this proceeding.

IS C,5330, OSH 68 Accordingly, Decision No. 82157 must be modified to the extent necessary to incorporate these later changes into MRT 4-B along with the specific revisions required by Decision No. 81518. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that: The petition of CMSA for continuance of the stay granted by Decision No. 82244 is hereby denied. 2. Decision No. 82157 is hereby modified, as necessary, to conform to the orders hereinafter set forth in Ordering Paragraphs 4 through 8. 3. The stay granted by Decision No. 82244 is hereby vacated. 4. Minimum Rate Tariff 4-B (Appendix C to Decision No. 65521, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective November 23, 1974, the supplement and revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, and by this reference made a part hereof. 5. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject also to Decision No. 65521, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the fifth day after the effective date of this order, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, and shall be made effective not later than November 23, 1974. 7. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendments authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such 3.

outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendments published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

8. In all other respects, Decision No. 65521, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order is effective on the date hereof.
