ORDER REVISING DECISION NO. 83229

By Decision No. 83229 issued August 6, 1974, the Commission amended Exception Ratings Tariff 1 (ERT 1) to conform certain item number references contained therein to certain changed item number references contained in National Motor Freight Classification 100A (NMF 100A). In so doing, the Commission inadvertently cancelled footnote (E) of Item 1030 of ERT 1 which reads:

"(E) Expires upon further order of the Commission."

This footnote expresses the Commission's policy that the exception ratings contained in ERT 1 are temporary and must be fully justified prior to being made permanent.

The California Trucking Association (CTA) has petitioned the Commission for rehearing, reconsideration, or revision of Decision No. 83229, requesting that footnote (E) be reinstated in Item 1030 of ERT 1. CTA argues that the deletion of footnote (E) constitutes a major substantive change in Commission policy. While the Commission does not believe that deletion of this single footnote demonstrates any change in its policy which has been fully set forth in several decisions, <sup>1/</sup> the footnote will be reinserted in Item 1030 of ERT 1.





IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 83229 is hereby revised to republish footnote (E) to Item 1030 of ERT 1.
