ORDER OF DISCONTINUANCE

On July 15, 1974, Hughes Airwest filed Tariff No. PF-1, Cal PUC No. 2, Revision Transmittal No. 20, providing for reduced air fares for five of its intrastate routes to be effective August 14, 1974. On subject petition of Swift Aire Lines, Inc., the Commission issued its Decision No. 83289 dated August 6, 1974 instituting an investigation into the reduced fares and suspending the operation of the tariff filing with respect to fares involving Santa Maria pending a hearing.

Hughes Airwest on August 12 filed Revision Transmittal No. 21 suspending all proposed new commuter fares except those formerly in effect, and on August 21 requested withdrawal of its Revision Transmittal No. 20 and the attendant tariff pages attached thereto. Once a tariff page has been filed it cannot be withdrawn. A new tariff page must be filed.

On August 21, 1974 Hughes Airwest also filed a motion to remove the above captioned matter from the Commission's docket and to dismiss the investigation. The issues in the investigation are now moot.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Hughes Airwest having suspended and requested withdrawal of its proposed new commuter fares shall file a revised tariff page cancelling the fares at issue in this proceeding and

retaining the fares presently in effect. Hughes Airwest shall concurrently cancel Supplement No. 1 to its California Intrastate Local Passenger Tariff No. PF-1. Such tariff filings may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and shall be made in accord with rules as prescribed in General Order No. 105-A.

2. The investigation instituted in Case No. 9772 is discontinued.




