SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Lads Furniture Freight, Inc., a California corporation, is a highway common carrier operating under a certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by this Commission. By the Certificate of Amendment of the Articles of Incorporation filed with the Secretary of the State of California on June 26, 1974, Lads Furniture Freight, Inc., changed its corporate name to Lads Freightways. A petition for change of corporate name having been filed by Lads Furniture Freight, Inc., its certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name and it will be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 80-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 61029 dated November 7, 1960 in Application No. 42078, as amended by Decision No. 62773 dated November 7, 1961

A. 42078, et al. - HK

in Application No. 43399 and by Decision No. 75892 dated July 8, 1969 in Application No. 51082, is hereby further amended by substituting the new corporate name "Lads Freightways" in the place and stead of "Lads Furniture Freight, Inc.," wherever it appears therein.

2. Within one hundred and twenty days after the date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Lads Freightways shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule No. 6.4 of General Order No. 80-A.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
