SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 83175 dated July 23, 1974 authorized the Southern Pacific Transportation Company to construct an industrial spur track at grade across Pacific Street in the City of Rocklin, County of Placer, to be identified as Crossing No. A-111.7-C, with protection to be two Standard No. 9A gates with cantilever signals (General Order No. 75-C).

The Southern Pacific Transportation Company by letter of September 6, 1974, File No. 921151/349-1, requests authority to operate over the crossing prior to installation of the ordered protection. In order to provide immediate service to the Fibreboard Corporation, it requests that interim protection of two Standard No. 1R signs be installed and train movements over the crossing be protected by a member of the train crew.

It is evident that the application essentially had requested the interim protection; however, as indicated in the railroad's letter, Decision No. 83175 was apparently silent on this point.

The Commission staff has reviewed the railroad's request and concludes that it is in the public interest and should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that for a period not to exceed nine months, protection may be as follows:

1. Two Standard No. 1R signs (General Order No. 75-C).

2. No on-rail vehicle shall be operated over the crossing unless it shall be first brought to a stop and vehicular traffic on Pacific Street protected by a member of the train crew or other competent employee acting as a flagman.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. In all other respects Decision No. 83175 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
