ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicants having requested by telegram, on September 30, 1974, an extension of time in which to comply with Ordering Paragraph 7 of Decision No. 81878, which relates to the exercise of rendering service under the certificate granted, the construction permit from the Federal Communications Commission having been received on September 20, 1974, said construction will not be completed by October 5, 1974, the date authorized by Decision No. 81878, and it appearing to the Commission that a three-month extension should be granted; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the time for compliance with Ordering Paragraph 7 of Decision No. 81878 is extended to and including January 5, 1975.

In all other respects, Decision No. 81878 shall remain in full force and effect.
