FINAL OPINION AND ORDER

Interim Decision No. 82909 dated May 29, 1974 herein, among other things, authorized Trans World Airlines, Inc. (TWA) to increase its jet commuter air fare for service between Los Angeles and San Francisco/Oakland to the level authorized to Pacific Southwest Airlines (PSA) in Application No. 54387. The interim fare (exclusive of security charges and transportation tax) authorized in Decision No. 82909 is \$18.06. The application seeks authority to establish a fare of \$18.29 (exclusive of security charges and transportation tax).

In Application No. 55199, filed September 23, 1974, TWA seeks an increase in its Los Angeles-San Francisco/Oakland jet commuter air fare to \$18.75 to match the fare authorized to PSA in Decision No. 83415 of September 4, 1974 in Application No. 54387. The request in Application No. 55199 supersedes the sought increase in TWA's Los Angeles-San Francisco/Oakland commuter air fare in the application herein.

Inasmuch as interim Decision No. 82909 disposed of all requests set forth in the application except with respect to the Los Angeles-San Francisco/Oakland jet commuter fare, and as that is superseded by the authority sought in Application No. 55199, Decision No. 82909 should be made final and, to the extent the application was not granted in said decision, Application No. 54861 should be dismissed.
