A. 55090 TLR 3. This project is a minor reconstruction of a railroad crossing categorically exempt under the provisions of Commission Rule 17.1(m)(B) 2. ORDER IT IS ORDERED that: 1. The Forest Service, Department of Agriculture, is authorized to reconstruct two existing Forest Service roads named Pilgrim Creek Road 42N13 and Shasta Forest Road 40N34Y at grade over the tracks of the McCloud River Railroad Company near McCloud in Siskiyou County at the location and substantially as shown by plans attached to the application to be identified, respectively, as public Crossings Nos. 26-3.4 and 26-5.2. 2. Construction of the crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 3 (General Order No. 72-B). 3. Width of crossings shall be not less than 24 feet with grades of approach as shown on the plans attached to the application. 4. Clearances shall conform to General Order No. 26-D. Walkways shall conform to General Order No. 118. 5. Protection at each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 1-R crossing signs (General Order No. 75-C). 6. Maintenance of the crossings shall be in accordance with General Order No. 72-B. 7. Construction expense of the crossings shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties, or if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. 8. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if the above conditions are not complied with. This authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. - 2 -
