ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By letter received October 2, 1974, Joseph C. Smyth and Vic Kleiwer have requested extension of time until December 1, 1974 to comply with ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 83202 dated July 30, 1974 in this proceeding. Ordering paragraph 1 of above decision requires the transfer of Raymond Water Works to the new owners Joseph C. Smyth and Vic Kleiwer on or before September 1, 1974.

Mr. Smyth and Mr. Kleiwer have taken over the property and have been operating the utility but have not received the transfer of the system due to a technicality. It is believed that the title and official transfer papers will be conveyed during October 1974.

The request for an extension of time, under the circumstances, is reasonable.

IT IS ORDERED that the time for compliance by Joseph C. Smyth and Vic Kleiwer with the provisions of ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 83202 herein is extended to and including December 1, 1974.
