ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By letter of October 3, 1974, T. J. and Grace Brassfield have requested an extension of time to comply with ordering paragraphs numbers 1.b. and 2 of Decision No. 81561, dated July 3, 1973, in the instant application. These orders have not been complied with due to the parties' unfamiliarities with the Commission's requirements in connection with filing instruments and documents related to transfer of ownership and loss of books and records of the water company. The request appears to be reasonable, and the Commission finds and concludes that the extension should be granted; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit for compliance with the requirements of ordering paragraphs numbers 1.b. and 2 of Decision No. 81561 is extended to and including December 1, 1974.
