## ORDER CONSOLIDATING PROCEEDINGS

Case No. 9728, Application No. 54839, and Case No. 9731 all concern various aspects of specialized common carrier communications service within California. These three matters were consolidated by Decision No. 82852 dated May 9, 1974.

In Application No. 55284, Southern Pacific Communications Company (SPCC) asks for the issuance of a certificate of public convenience and necessity to commence intrastate operation of its communication line between San Francisco and Los Angeles, without prejudice to its position taken in Cases Nos. 9728 and 9731 that no such certificate is necessary.

SPCC asks in its application that the Commission either dismiss Application No. 55284 on the ground that no such certificate is required from this Commission, or, in the alternative, that the Commission issue its certificate of public convenience and necessity to allow SPCC to provide microwave point-to-point communications service over its line between San Francisco and Los Angeles and various intermediate points.

Application No. 55284 is accompanied by a motion to dismiss it for the grounds set forth in various briefs SPCC has filed in the remaining above-mentioned matters.

It appearing that certain common issues of law and fact are present in the above-captioned proceedings,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Application No. 55284 is consolidated for hearing with Application No. 54839, Case No. 9728, and Case No. 9731.
