ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicant has requested an extension of time within which to comply with Ordering Paragraph 2 of Decision No. 83486. Ordering Paragraph 2 was to be complied with by October 14, 1974. In substantial compliance therewith applicant, by letter dated October 17, 1974, has advised the Commission that the revenue per car for line-haul cars switched will be at least \$47.20.
