1. Ordering Paragraph 2(a) of Decision No. 83139 dated July 16, 1974 is amended to read as follows:




Applicant is placed on notice that if it accepts the certificate it will be required, among other things, to comply with the safety rules administered by the California Highway Patrol, the rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order No. 98-Series, and the insurance requirements of the Commission's General Order No. 101-Series.


2. Ordering Paragraph 2(b) of Decision No. 83139 dated July 16, 1974 is amended to read as follows:

- (b) Within one hundred eighty days after the effective date of this order, applicant shall establish the authorized service and file tariffs and timetables in triplicate, in the Commission's office.
