ORDER OF SUSPENSION

Contra Costa Terminals, Inc. requests authority to suspend service as a public utility warehouseman in 3,000 square feet of storage space in the city of Concord for a period of two years because of a lack of business.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive authority to operate as a public utility warehouseman in the city of Concord as set forth in Commission order dated August 1, 1960 in Case No. 6698 is suspended until December 1, 1976.

2. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

applicant shall amend its tariffs presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
