ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Industrial Communications Systems, Inc. has, by petition filed July 1, 1974, requested a third extension of time beyond that previously granted by Decisions Nos. 82387 and 82302 within which to comply with provisions of Decision No. 81797, dated August 28, 1973, because of inability to reach agreement on a contract with Pacific Telephone. It appearing to the Commission that an extension of two years should be granted, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the time for compliance with Decision No. 81797 is extended to and including July 14, 1976.

In all other respects, Decision No. 81797 shall remain in full force and effect.
