
Marvin Sid Allsop and Louise E. Allsop seek authority to control Fitch Mountain Water Company, Inc., a California corporation operating a public utility water system in a portion of Sonoma County.

James G. Hendrickson and Ruth H. Hendrickson, owners of the 3,900 outstanding shares of capital stock of Fitch Mountain Water Company, Inc., propose to sell and transfer said 3,900 shares to Marvin Sid Allsop and Louise E. Allsop. The application indicates that the proposed transferees are financially responsible and that Marvin Sid Allsop, a civil engineer, has had 15 years experience in water supply and development.

After consideration the Commission finds that control of Fitch Mountain Water Company, Inc. by Marvin Sid Allsop and Louise E. Allsop would not be adverse to the public interest, and concludes that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary. The action taken herein shall not be construed as a finding of the value of the capital stock of Fitch Mountain Water Company, Inc.
