ORDER DISCONTINUING PROCEEDING

Pursuant to the Commission's interim ex parte order in Decision No. 81326 dated May 1, 1973, premium volume incentive service charges were established on June 2, 1973 in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 on a temporary basis pending public hearing. The tariff provisions were initially subject to expire June 30, 1974. This expiration date was subsequently extended to June 30, 1975.

Further consideration of the premium volume incentive tariff provisions should now be incorporated into the contemplated Commission staff's Minimum Rate Tariff 2 full scale cost and rate economic studies. In the circumstances, the public hearing ordered to be held relative to the final disposition of Petition 739 by Decision No. 81326 is no longer necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The tenth ordering paragraph of Decision No. 81326 dated May 1, 1973 in Case No. 5432 is canceled.

2. To the extent not canceled herein, the Commission's order in Decision No. 81326 shall remain in full force and effect.

3. The proceeding involving Petition for Modification
No. 739 in Case No. 5432 is discontinued.
