ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision No. 83216 dated July 30, 1974 granted authority to operate a public utility warehouse in Vernon and provided in Ordering Paragraph 2(b) that tariffs should be filed within one hundred twenty days after the effective date of the decision. Applicant has requested that a reasonable extension of time be granted due to delays caused by factors beyond its control.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The time period specified in Ordering Paragraph 2(b) of Decision No. 83216 dated July 30, 1974 within which Data Transportation Co., Inc. shall file tariffs in the Commission's office is extended to April 1, 1975.

2. In all other respects, Decision No. 83216 shall remain in full force and effect.
