ORDER

A petition for rehearing of Decision No. 83574, issued October 8, 1974 to be effective twenty days thereafter, was filed by California Trucking Association on October 18, 1974. In accordance with Section 1733 of the Public Utilities Code, the filing of this petition for rehearing suspended the order in Decision No. 83574 for a period up to sixty days, pending further order of the Commission. The Commission, on its own motion, is of the opinion that the suspension of the order in said decision should be continued. Continuation of the suspension is ordered for the sole purpose of affording the Commission sufficient time to fully evaluate the contentions of said petition for rehearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the suspension of the order in Decision No. 83574 shall be continued until further order of the Commission.
