ORDER DISCONTINUING PROCEEDING

By Decision No. 82905 dated May 29, 1974 in Case No. 5432 (Petition 780) et al., methods for offsetting fuel cost increases in the Commission's several minimum rate tariffs were established. The decision also provided that this consolidated proceeding remain open to consider further interim decisions and orders as the then existing circumstances surrounding the fuel emergency may require. 3. The proceeding involving Petitions for Modification Nos. 780, 80, 49, 155, 259, 94, 199, 89, 286, 138, 41, 25, 85, 92, and 26 in Cases Nos. 5432, 5330, 5433, 5436, 5437, 5438, 5439, 5440, 5441, 5603, 5604, 6008, 7783, 7857, and 8808, respectively, is discontinued.
