OAKLEY, an individual, HUMBLE OIL & REFINING CORP., a Delaware corporation, ATLANTIC RICHFIELD COMPANY, a Pennsylvania corporation, REDWOOD COAST LUMBER CO., INC., a California corporation, and JESS RAWLES, an individual.

ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision No. 82085 dated November 7, 1973, as amended by Decision No. 82599 dated March 19, 1974, ordered Evan E. Oakley to pay a punitive fine of \$500 in five \$100 installments, with the first payment due on March 25, 1974 and the remaining installments on the twenty-fifth day of each of the four succeeding months. Installments of \$100 were paid on April 15, 1974, May 28, 1974, June 25, 1974, and September 10, 1974.

Respondent wrote on November 19, 1974 to advise that his business has dropped to 10 percent of its former volume and request that the time within which to pay the final installment be extended to after January 25, 1975.

The Transportation Division has no objection. Respondent has paid \$4,631.92 on the total sum due. ✓

IT IS ORDERED that the time within which to pay the final installment of \$100 on the fine imposed by Decision No. 82085, as amended by Decision No. 82398, is extended to March 1, 1975.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
