ORDER OF DISMISSAL

California-American Water Company seeks authority to issue a \$1,000,000 term note to Bank of America National Trust and Savings Association.

After consideration the Commission finds that:

1. Applicant filed this application on October 3, 1974.
2. By letter dated December 17, 1974, Bank of America National Trust and Savings Association informed applicant to the effect that the terms pertaining to the proposed \$1,000,000 financing are still being formulated.
3. Applicant filed this application prematurely.

On the basis of the foregoing findings we conclude that the application should be dismissed without prejudice to the filing of a new application after all the terms of the proposed financing have been established. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 55231 is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
